*Second Film Set for Release in October, Vignette Filming Completed, and  
Pre-Production of Third Film*

WASHINGTON, DC, September 7, 2007 — Starship Farragut, an independent film project based on the original series of Star Trek, today announced that it recently completed the filming of a short film called, "Just Passing Through". This first 'vignette' provides a backdrop story for two of the four main principal characters of the series.

"After wrapping up for our second episodic film in late May, we immediately coordinated efforts with our cast and crew to film a vignette, as well as begin pre-production efforts for the third episode," said John Broughton, Executive Producer. "This project continues to be a great creative outlet for everyone involved, and we're committed to delivering innovative stories for our audience to enjoy. In fact, the second adventure for the Farragut crew takes place back on Earth, but in America's past."

Starship Farragut's "For Want of a Nail" is currently in post-production with NEO f/x ([www.neo-fx.com](http://www.neo-fx.com)) which provides state-of-the art, digital effects for the project, and is scheduled for Internet release on October 10<sup>th</sup>. The project is currently in pre-production of its third episodic film entitled, "Fathers and Sons," which will be released next year.
