Fans recreate 'Star Trek' in their own way

With no more television spinoffs of the popular 1960s "Star Trek" series, film fans are creating their own in Virginia, The New York Times reported.

Paul Sieber and his team of dedicated Star Trek fans are reportedly filming "Starship Farragut," a spinoff filmed with a \$6,000 digital camera. The spinoff is being filmed in the woods of Virginia.

Sieber, a 40-year-old engineer for a government contractor, is not the only fan spearheading a recreation of "Star Trek." According to the Times, up to two-dozen fan-made "Star Trek" projects around the world are in various stages of production.

Paramount, which owns the rights to "Star Trek," reportedly is tolerant of spinoffs and recreations as long as no one is profiting from the work.
